KOWHAIWHAI PANELS

Last week, we shared with you some information about the kowhaiwhai panels. This week, here is a photo of last year's Room 5 LEGENDs and the story behind their design.

Room 5's Kowhaiwhai pattern is a koru pattern known as the Koiri. The koiri is a symbol of self-reflection, nurturing, and it also means to flourish.

Our koiri is reflected or mirrored through the centreline. The koru pattern is repeated, and it continues indefinitely. The meaning for our class is a journey of learning that never ends. Everyone starts their journey at a different point. Our peers / friends / family are also learning alongside us (the mirrored part). We respect, encourage, and learn from each other.
